My story is a Suffolk story. This is where I raised my kids, both proud Ward Melville High School graduates. I taught at Stony Brook University for more than 20 years, serving as the chair of the Chemistry Department. And I started and ran a non-profit that beat more than 20 Moms for Liberty MAGA extremist candidates candidates, keeping them from banning books in our schools.

When I see problems, I bring people together to fix them. When I see MAGA extremists pushing dangerous ideas, I stop them.

When MAGA extremists were trying to ban books that spoke the truth about kids' LGBTQ experiences or about our nation's history with slavery, I brought people together to stop them. **We defeated 20**Moms for Liberty MAGA school board candidates – keeping them out of our schools and keeping their dangerous ideas from harming our kids.

As a leader at Stony Brook University, my team identified that there was a small group of workers who could not access health insurance through the university. That didn't sit right with me, and I knew something had to be done. So, I pushed for a solution, creating a plan to provide health insurance to these workers.

As a scientist, I called out Republicans for ignoring climate change. To protect Long Island, we must protect our water, our open space, and our climate. That's why, in my research lab, we helped create technologies to make renewable energy like solar more reliable and affordable.

Now I'm running for Congress, because I can't stomach how our current Congressman Nick LaLota pretends to be a moderate, while voting with the same MAGA Republicans who want to ban abortion nationwide.

In Congress, I'll use my experience to:

- **Defend our democracy and fight back against MAGA extremists.** I've already taken on MAGA on Long Island, and I'm ready to continue that fight in Washington.
- Write abortion rights into national law. I've defended reproductive rights for decades in Suffolk County and am proud to be honored for my activism by Planned Parenthood.
- Ban assault weapons and push for stronger criminal and mental health background checks for all gun purchases. I'm honored to be recognized by Moms Demand Action as a gun sense candidate.
- Work to cut costs for Long Islanders and help local businesses. At Stony Brook, I created a plan to provide health insurance for workers who didn't have it, because no one should be overwhelmed by the high cost of healthcare.
- Protect our water, open space, and environment. I've called out local officials for ignoring climate change and helped create technologies that make renewable energy sources more reliable and affordable.
